Baritone

German baritone Dominik Köninger's current projects include **DONNER** *Das Rheingold* **Dresdner Musikfestspiele**, **Kölner Philharmonie**, **Lucerne Festival** (Kent Nagano) **HOMONAY** *Der Zigeunerbaron*, **VICTORIAN SILVIUS** in Oscar Straus' *Die Perlen der Cleopatra*, **ORFEO** in Monteverdi's *L'Orfeo* **Komische Oper Berlin** and *Billy Budd* (title role) **Musiktheater im Revier Gelsenkirchen**.

Dominik was a member of the **Komische Oper Berlin** ensemble, singing roles such as **PELLÉAS** *Pelléas et Mélisande*, **FIGARO** *Il Barbiere di Siviglia*, **PAPAGENO** *Die Zauberflöte*, **GUGLIELMO** *Così fan tutte*, **CONTE** *Le nozze di Figaro*, **PANTALONE** *The Love for Three Oranges*, **AGAMEMNON** *La belle Helene* and *Giulio Cesare in Egitto* (title role). Past guest appearances have included **PAPAGENO** **Edinburgh International Festival**, **Gran Teatre del Liceu**, **Staatsoper Hamburg** and **Deutsche Oper am Rhein**, **FALKE** *Die Fledermaus* **Staatstheater Stuttgart**, **DANDINI** *La Cenerentola* and **FALKE** **Volkoper Wien**, **MERCURIO** *L'Incoronazione di Poppea* and **KILIAN** *Der Freischütz* **Theater an der Wien**, and projects with **Ludwigsburger Schloßfestspielen**, **Schwetzingen Festspiele** and **Badisches Staatstheater Karlsruhe**. Together with the pianist Volker Krafft he was the winner of the 2011 **Wigmore Hall International Song Competition**. As a member of the **Tiroler Landestheater** he sang roles such as **OTTOKAR** *Der Freischütz*, **FALKE** and **GUGLIELMO**.

In concert, Dominik appeared in **Festspielhaus Baden-Baden**, **Stuttgarter Liederhalle**, **Philharmonie Berlin**, **Laeiszhalle Hamburg**, **Concertgebouw Amsterdam**, **Bozar Brussels**, **De Singel Antwerp**, **Rudolfinum Prag**, **Schleswig-Holstein Musik Festivals** and **Litauische Nationaloper Vilnius** with ensembles such as **Hamburger Symphoniker Orchestre** **Philharmonique de Monte Carlo** and **B'Rock Baroque Orchestra Gent**.

Dominik was born in Heidelberg, studied at **Operschule Karlsruhe** and was a member of the **International Opera Studio, Staatsoper Hamburg**.
