



## Martha Jones Mezzo Soprano

Martha Jones's current and future engagements include HERMIA *A Midsummer Night's Dream* **Nevill Holt Opera**, SOLOIST **Scottish Opera Highlights Tour**, DAUGHTER *Akhnaten* **English National Opera**, as well as SOLOIST Michael Haydn and Mozart *Requiem* **Palace of Versailles.** In future seasons, she returns to **English Touring Opera** and **English National Opera**.

She also performed Mahler's *Das Lied von der Erde* **London Mahler Orchestra**, Mahler's *Lieder Eines Fahrenden Gesellen* **RCM Philharmonia**, and OLGA *Eugene Onegin*, HELEN/ERIS *In the Belly of the Horse* and ROSINA cover *Barber of Seville* **English Touring Opera**. She has also performed HÄNSEL and DORABELLA **Woodhouse Opera**, JENNIE FOXCUB Tobias Picker's *Fantastic Mr. Fox*, TEODATA (cover) Handel's *Flavio* and ANNIO (cover) *La Clemenza di Tito* **English Touring Opera**, and CHERUBINO *Le Nozze di Figaro* **British Youth Opera**.

Martha studied at **Durham University**, as well as with Janis Kelly at the **Royal College of Music International Opera School**. Whilst at the **RCM** she received the Baroness de Turckheim award, an MBF award, the Marjorie and Dorothy Whyte Memorial Award and a Susan Chilcott Scholarship. She was also supported in her studies by the Sophie's Silver Lining Fund and the Josephine Baker Trust. Martha was a finalist in the Great Elm Vocal Award 2010, and she was awarded prizes in the RCM Schumann Competition and the Chelsea Schubert Festival.

Performances at the RCMIOS include HÄNSEL Hänsel und Gretel, ROSINA II Barbiere di Siviglia, DORABELLA Cosi fan tutte, ZWEITE DAME Die Zauberflöte, HEN The Cunning Little Vixen and CUPID Orpheus in the Underworld.

Martha is a Britten-Pears Young Artist and a Samling Scholar and has given recitals at St John's Smith Square, the National Portrait Gallery and for the Ryedale Festival with Christopher Glynn.

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
