Ms. Slack is an Artistic Advisor for **Portland Opera**, Co-Director for the 2020-21 Opera Program at the **Banff Centre for the Performing Arts**, and Co-Chair of the **Women's Opera Network** with **Opera America**.

She made her **Metropolitan Opera** and international radio broadcast debuts in the title role of *Luisa Miller*, and made her **Carnegie Hall** debut as AGNES SOREL in Tchaikovsky's *Maid of Orleans*, a role she also performed with the **San Francisco Opera**.

She has also sung SERENA *Porgy and Bess* Washington National Opera and San Francisco Opera, Mahler Symphony No. 2 with The Latvian National Symphony, Beethoven Symphony No. 9 with Alabama Symphony, *Verdi Requiem* Madison Symphony and Sacramento Choral Society, Bach's *St. Matthew's Passion* and Handel's *Messiah* with the Messiah Festival of the Arts in Kansas and Vaughan Williams' *Dona Nobis Pacem* with the Sacramento Choral Society, the role of CILLA in Richard Danielpour's American opera *Margaret Garner* Michigan Opera Theater, and her featured role in Tyler Perry's movie and soundtrack "For Colored Girls" as the Opera Diva.

Karen is a native of Philadelphia and a graduate of the Santa Fe Opera Apprentice Program, the Steans Institute of the Ravinia Festival, the Adler Fellowship at the San Francisco Opera and the Curtis Institute of Music.
