Other past engagements have included NIMMING NED *The Beggar's Opera* (Lorin Maazel) **Castleton Festival**; and the world premiere of Simon Sargon's *Out of the Depths* with **Voices of Change** in Dallas. He sang ZURGA *The Pearl Fishers*, LUNA *Il Trovatore*, FALKE *Die Fledermaus*, FORD *Falstaff*, SHARPLESS *Madama Butterfly* and the title roles in *Don Giovanni* and *Gianni Schicchi* **Opera San Jose**.

He received awards from the **Marilyn Horne Foundation** and the **Metropolitan Opera National Council District Auditions**. He received his graduate degree from **Manhattan School of Music**, where he sang FALKE *Die Fledermaus*, TARQUINIUS *The Rape of Lucretia* and JOE HARLAND in John Musto's *Later the Same Evening*, (released on **Albany Records**).
